Stonkleen FS9 Liquid Enzyme Degreaser is a heavy duty cleaner effective in cleaning and degreasing food fats and oils.

TYPICAL USES

Stonkleen FS9 is formulated for the food processing and food service industries. It's also effective on restroom floors.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For standard cleaning of soiled floors.

- Dilute 2 oz. of Liquid Enzyme Degreaser with one gallon of water.
- Apply to floor surface with mop or auto scrubber.
- Rinse with water.

For cleaning extremely soiled floors.

- Dilute 8 oz. of FS9 Liquid Enzyme Degreaser with one gallon of water.
- Apply to floor surface with mop or auto scrubber.
- Rinse with water.

For heavy solid spot removal.

- Use concentrated Stonkleen FS9.
- Apply to floor with a small amount of water and agitate.
- Allow to penetrate for 2 to 3 minutes.
- Extract and rinse thoroughly.

PACKAGING

Stonkleen FS9 is available in units.

Each unit consists of:

(4) 1-gallon containers (FG#8106A41)

or

(1) 5-gallon container (FG# 8106A5)

STORAGE CONDITIONS

Store Stonkleen FS9 between 60 to 85°F/16 to 30°C. Keep from freezing.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- The dilution ratios stated are approximations. Adjust your dilution ratio to optimize cleaning performance or to effect greater economy.

PRECAUTIONS

- Always read and follow the instructions on the product label & SDS before use.
- Use cleaning liquids in well-ventilated areas to avoid inhaling fumes.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment such as gloves & safety glasses to protect your skin and eyes.
